Jesus did many amazing things, but he was not always appreciated. in fact, sometimes even his closest friends and family rejected Jesus and thought he was getting too big for his boots. Jesus knew what it was like to seem to fail in ministry. In his hometown of Nazareth, he was just not able to make an impact, and he prepared his own disciples for failure when he sent them out on their own mission tour. There is an important lesson for us all here. When we follow Christ and do his will we should always be prepared for rejection and failure. As Lynn Anderson sang so beautifully, God also "never promised us a rose garden".
