

# Thought for the weekend: where would you like to sit in the Kingdom of Heaven?

James and John approached Jesus with a request, they wanted a guarantee that when Jesus gained power he would share it with them. They had understood that Jesus was about to bring in a new world order, but they failed to understand just how different it would be. Jesus was about to embark upon his triumphant entry into Jerusalem, and the crowds who would cheer him will make the same mistake.
