There are some people with loved ones in hospital and their journey each day is to visit the sick, not shop in crowded streets. There are others who cannot be happy because of the loss of somebody dear to them and Christmas just makes missing them feel so much worse. Then of course there are others who feel miserable that they cannot enjoy Christmas because it all seems to cost so much money and there just isn't enough to go around. It is important that Christ came as a light because the world which he joined was in darkness.
